CHAPTER 207.

Passed Mar. 19, An act to promote the improvement of the Drama and 1839. Musical Science in the City of Baltimore.

Premble WHEREAS, it has been represented to this General Assembly by certain citizens of the City of Baltimore, that it would greatly tend to the improvement of the drama and musical science, by granting an act of incorporation to a company for that purpose,—Therefore,

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Columbus O'Donnell, William Dickinson, Recordy Johnson, Charles F. Mayer, Samuel W. Smith, John P. Kennedy, George G. Belt, Jacob G. Davis, John B. Howell, Thomas D. Johnson, Joseph Robinson, and all such persons as shall associate with them by becoming stockholders in the manner hereinafter provided, their successors and assigns, shall be, and they are hereby created and constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name,
