missioners, appointed under the provisions of this act, CHAP. 238, all the books and papers appertaining, or in any way belonging to the levy court and commissioners of the tax hereby abolished.

Sec. 14 And be it enacted. That all laws inconsist. Acts inconsistent, ent with the provisions of this act, be, and the same are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 236.

An act to divorce Mary Ann Farrell, of the City of Passed Mar. 25, Baltimore, from her husband James W. Farrell. 1839.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Divese That Mary Aun Farrell, of the city of Baltimore, be, and she is hereby divorced from her lrusband James W. Farrell, a vinculo matrimonii.

CHAPTER 287.

An act to extend the time for receiving the subscriptions Passed Mar. 25, to the capital stock, of the Farmers' and Millers' 1839.

Bank of Washington county.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Vine extended That the time for receiving subscriptions to the capital stock, of the Farmers' and Millers' Bank of Washington county, be and the same is hereby extended to the first day of March eighteen hundred and forty.

CHAPTER 238.

An act to provide for the repair and preservation of a Passed Mar. 25, certain Bridge, in St. Mary's county.

WHEREAS, it has been represented to this General Presented Assembly by the memorial of soundry citizens of St. Mary's country, that the bridge over the head waters of St. Mary's river, in said country, has been seriously damaged by a freshet, during the past year:—Therefore,
