Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Divorce
 That Mary Ann Farrell, of the city of Baltimore, be,
 and she is hereby divorced from her husband James W.
 Farrell, *a vinculo matrimonii.*

CHAPTER 237.

An act to extend the time for receiving the subscriptions Passed Mar. 25,
to the capital stock, of the Farmers' and Millers' 1839.
Bank of Washington county.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Time extended
 That the time for receiving subscriptions to the capital
 stock, of the Farmers' and Millers' Bank of Washing-
 ton county, be and the same is hereby extended to the
 first day of March eighteen hundred and forty.
