CHAPTER 26.

Passed Jan. 28, 1839. *An act to alter and change the names of James Francis Corkran and Thomas Henry Corkran, of Caroline county, to James Francis Love and Thomas Henry Love.*

Names changed

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland.* That the names of James Francis Corkran and Thomas Henry Corkran, children of Nancy Corkran of Caroline county, be and they are hereby respectively changed and altered to the names of James Francis Love and Thomas Henry Love, and it shall and may be lawful for the said James Francis Corkran and Thomas Henry Corkran at all times hereafter to be called and known by, and hold and use the names of James Francis Love and Thomas Henry Love, and by said names to sell, purchase, convey and devise, and to sue and be sued in any court of law or equity.

Contracts and obligations confirmed

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted.* That all securities, promises, contracts, assurances, deeds and lawful acts whatever, hereafter to be made or done, by or to the said James Francis Corkran and Thomas Henry Corkran, by the names of James Francis Love and Thomas Henry Love, shall be of the same force and effect and equally valid to all intents and purposes as if the names of James Francis Love and Thomas Henry Love had been their first and original names.

CHAPTER 27.

Passed Jan. 28, 1839. *An act to authorise Addison B. Reily to remove into this State, two negroes, slaves for life.*

Permission granted

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland. That Addison B. Reily of the city of Baltimore, be and
