

CHAP. 248. of justice whatsoever; and also to have, make and use a common seal, and the same to break, alter and renew at pleasure, and also to assemble and meet at such times and places as they may agree upon; and to ordain, establish and put in execution such bye laws, ordinances and regulations as to them shall seem conducive to the interest of said company, and necessary to the good government and orderly management thereof, the same not being contrary to the laws of this State, or of the United States, or of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, and generally to do and execute all such acts, matters and things, as to them shall or may appertain to do.

CHAPTER 247.

Passed Mar. 27, 1839, *A further supplement to an act, entitled, an act for the benefit of John S. Crockett and Cadmus Dashiell, Administrators of Matthias Dashiell.*

Extended 1 year

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the act, entitled, an act for the benefit of John S. Crockett and Cadmus Dashiell, administrators of Matthias Dashiell, passed December session eighteen hundred and thirty-five, which expired by its own limitation on the tenth day of February, eighteen hundred and thirty-seven, and which was extended for one year from the eighteenth day of March eighteen hundred and thirty-seven, and which was again extended for one year, by an act of Assembly, passed the twentieth day of February, eighteen hundred and thirty-eight, be, and the same is hereby extended, and shall continue in full force, for one year and no more, from the passage of this act.
