CHAPTER 256.

An act to authorise the Commissioners of Cecil county, to levy a sum of money to be appropriated to the erection of a Bridge over Back Creek, at or near Bohemia Village. Passed Mar. 27, 1839

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Kendal S. Croper, Tobias F. Biddle, and Joseph Bryan, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners, for the purpose of locating and building a bridge over said creek, and the said commissioners, or a majority of them, are by this act, empowered and authorised to agree and contract with any person, or persons, upon the most economical terms, to construct said bridge. Commissioners named To contract, &c

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said commissioners shall keep an accurate account of the money expended in erecting said bridge, and in case there should be any money left unexpended, after the building of said bridge, the same shall be returned to the commissioners of Cecil county, to be applied for the benefit of the county. Case of any surplus

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That a majority of said commissioners, shall be competent to transact any business relating to said bridge, and if either of said commissioners shall die, resign, or remove out of the county, the commissioners of Cecil county, shall fill such vacancies, and the county commissioners are hereby authorized to make such reasonable compensation to said bridge commissioners, as they in their judgement may deem right. Sec. 4. *And be it enacted,* That the commissioners of Cecil county, be and they are hereby authorized and required at their next annual levy, to levy upon the assessable property of said county; *provided,* the Chesapeake, and Delaware Canal Company, shall Levy authorised Proviso
