over to said bridge commissioners, or their order, the CHAP. 256. above mentioned accounts, provided they do not exceed rayment directed the sum of six hundred dollars, including a reasonable Limit compensation to the aforesaid bridge commissioners, for their services.

CHAPTER 256.

An act to authorise the Commissioners of Cecil county, Passed Mar. 27, to levy a sum of money to be appropriated to the erection of a Bridge over Back Creek, at or near Bohemia Village.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of column Maryland, That Kendal S. Croper, Tobias F. Biddle, and Joseph Bryan, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners, for the purpose of locating and building a bridge over said creek, and the said commissioners, or a majority of them, are by this act, empowered and authorised to agree and contract with any person, To contract, &c or persons, upon the most economical terms, to con-

struct said bridge.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the said commis. Case of any surplus sioners shall keep an accurate account of the money expended in erecting said bridge, and in case there should be any money left unexpended, after the building of said bridge, the same shall be returned to the commissioners of Cecil county, to be applied for the benefit of the county.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That a majority of said quorum commissioners, shall be competent to transact any business relating to said bridge, and if either of said commissioners shall die, resign, or remove out of the Case of vacancy county, the commissioners of Cecil county, shall fill such vacancies, and the county commissioners are hereby authorized to make such reasonable compensa-Compensation tion to said bridge commissioners, as they in their judgement may deem right.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That the commissioners Levy authorised of Cecil county, be and they are hereby authorized and required at their next annual levy, to levy upon the assessable property of said county; provided, the Provide Chesapeake, and Delaware Canal Company, shall
