LEVY COURT

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Commissioners' Court abolished
 That from and after the passage of this act,
 the commissioners' court of Calvert county be, and the
 same is hereby abolished.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That Levin W. Ballard, Levy Court institu- ted
 Levin Stanforth, James S. Morsell, Uriah Laveille,
 James Harrison, Benjamin Harrison, be, and the
 same are hereby created a board to be styled the
 Levy Court of Calvert county, who shall exercise
 all the powers, and perform all the duties heretofore
 required to be performed by the commissioners' court
 of said county, until the election of members of said
 court hereinafter provided for.
