Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the said fund is hereby pledged for the payment of the said subscription hereby authorized; *provided*, the president and directors of the said Chesapeake Steam Towing Company, shall file with the said treasurer, a copy of a resolution passed at a meeting of the stockholders thereof, authorizing all bay vessels of this State, to pass through the track, or tracks, opened by their several boats, free of charge; *provided*, the tonnage of said bay vessels shall not exceed sixty-tons.

## CHAPTER 263.

*An act authorizing the Commissioners of Baltimore County to appoint Trustees to the Poor of said county.* Passed Mar. 27, 1839.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That from and after the first day of February, eighteen hundred and forty, the commissioners of Baltimore county shall appoint three efficient and well qualified persons from said county, to act as trustees to the poor of said county, and such appointment shall be made annually on the first Monday in February, or at their first meeting thereafter.

May appoint three trustees annually

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That no trustee shall serve for more than five successive years, unless he shall receive the unanimous vote of the board of commissioners.
