Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, CHAP. 32. That an election be held in the Boonsborough or sixth Election directed election district of Washington county, on the first Monday of March next, and that in the conducting of the said election and making the return thereof, the judges of election shall conform in all respects to the existing laws in relation to the elections, and that the Sheriff of said county shall give the usual notice of Notice thereof said election, and that in all cases hereafter, where there shall be a tie, between two or more candidates In case of tie heres for the office of county commissioner in said county, the Sheriff of said county as soon as such tie is ascertained to exist, shall issue his proclamation command- Election directed ing a new election in such district, giving the usual notice required by law, which election shall be held in all respects according to the provisions of the election laws of this State.

## CHAPTER 31.

An act to change the name of Thomas Hebb, of Caleb, to Passed Jan. 30, Thomas Broome Hebb, of St. Mary's County. 1839.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Name changed That the name of Thomas Hebb of Caleb, of St. Mary's county, be and the same is hereby changed to Thomas Broome Hebb, and that he shall be at all times, and in all respects entitled to use the name of Thomas Broome Hebb, as if the same had been given him in baptism.
