Sec. 19. And be it enacted, That this act shall com-CHAP. 269. mence and be in force from and after the passage inforce thereof.

Sec. 20. And be it enacted, That no company claim-nucking forbiding the benefits of this act, shall exercise any banking privilege, or have the right to issue any note in the nature of a hank rate.

CHAPTER 268.

An act to revive the twelfth, thirteenth, fourteenth and Passed Mat. 28, fifteenth sections of an act, passed December session eighteen hundred and fifteen, chapter one hundred and sixty-six, entitled, an act to incorporate a Company to make a Turupike Road from the Frederick and Baltimore Turupike Road, commencing at the west end of Frederick Town, to Harper's Ferry, on the Palance River.
