Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the Register of Wills for said county, be authorized and required to obtain a sufficient number of well bound books, and cause an accurate and full index or key to all administrations recorded in said office from the year eighteen hundred and twenty three inclusive to the year eighteen hundred and twenty nine inclusive.

Levy for expenses
thereof

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the Levy Court of said county, be required to levy on the assessable property of said county, such sum of money, as shall be sufficient to pay the cost of the necessary books and such compensation for the duties herein required as is now allowed by law for similar services, and that the said sum of money be collected as other county charges are collected, and the same to be paid over to the Register of Wills for said county, when the duties herein required shall have been performed, *Provided nevertheless,* that the entire cost shall not exceed the sum of

three hundred dollars; *And provided also,* That before the Register of Wills of Dorchester county shall proceed to execute the provisions of this act, it shall be the duty of the Judges of the Orphan's court of said county (or a majority of them) to ascertain and determine whether the work herein required to be executed is necessary and requisite for the public interest, and if they shall so determine, it shall be the duty of the Register of Wills, under the direction of said court, with all convenient despatch to carry into effect the provisions of this act.

CHAPTER 33.

Passed Jan. 30, 1839. *An act to change the place of holding the election in the Eleventh Election district of Baltimore County.*

Authority granted
to fix place

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners of Baltimore county, are hereby authorized and directed to establish the place of holding the election for the eleventh election District of Baltimore county, at the most convenient and suitable place, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.
