CHAPTER 287.

A supplement to an act, entitled, an act for the benefit Passed Mar. 9,
1839.
*and relief of the citizens of Worcester County, and
all persons concerned in the records thereof, which
may have been destroyed by the burning of the court
house of said county, passed at December session
eighteen hundred and thirty-five, chapter two hundred
and seventy-nine.*

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Production of ori-
ginal judgment
dispensed with
That from and after the passage of this act, it shall
not be incumbent on any plaintiff or defendant, in
any suit now pending, or hereafter to be brought,
to produce the original judgment, or the record thereof,
to entitle such plaintiff or defendant to produce in evi-
dence any fieri facias, or capias ad satisfaciendum,
issued by the clerk of Worcester county court, but such
party may produce such fieri facias, or capias ad satis-
faciendum, or an authenticated copy, or record thereof,
and the same shall be legal and competent evidence,
and the recitals in said fieri facias, or capias ad satis-
faciendum, shall be prima facie evidence of the judg-
ment so recited; *provided nevertheless*, that this law Proviso
shall not extend to any judgment rendered since the
first day of January, eighteen hundred and thirty-five.
