CHAPTER 290.

An act to authorise Thomas Jones, of Charles County, Maryland, to sell and convey certain land, in Alle- Passed Mar. 8,
gany County. 1839.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Authority to con-
 That Thomas Jones, of Charles county, Maryland, be, vey
 and he is hereby authorised and empowered, to sell
 and convey in fee simple, a tract of land lying in Al-
 legany county, Maryland, which said land was patent-
 ed to Mary Ellen Jones and Edward Jones, infant
 children of Silias M. Jones, in virtue of an act of the
 General Assembly of Maryland, passed at December
 session, eighteen hundred and thirty-six, chapter one
 hundred and seventeen; *provided however*, that said
 Thomas Jones, before he shall proceed to sell said
 land, shall first file with the orphans' court of Charles
 county, a bond to be approved of by said court, and
 conditioned for the faithful performance of his trust;
 that he report said sale to said court, and that the pro-
 ceeds of said sale shall be applied for the benefit of said
 infant children, under the order and direction of said
 court, and that this act shall take effect from after the
 passage thereof.
