An act to divorce Marsilina Clarke from her husband Passed Mar. 14, Baly L. Clarke. 1839.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Director That Marsilina Clarke be, and she is hereby declared to be divorced from her husband Baly L. Clark, a vincula matrimani.

CHAPTER 294.

A supplement to an act, entitled, an act to establish Pamod Mar. 8, Magistrates' Courts in the several counties of this 1850. State, and to prescribe their jurisdiction, passed peccember session, eighleen hundred and thirty-five, chapter two hundred and one.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Compensations Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, Jagon the district justices of the district or the several election districts in Worcester county, shall be entitled to their fees according to the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, insited of their per diem allowance, and they shall not be entitled to any per diem allowance whatever.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted. That the twenty-fourth puberson section of the act to which this is a supplement be, and with same is hereby repealed, so far as the same relates at a new to Worcester county, except so much of the second section, providing that the chief justices shall furnish neaper to the levy court, or commissioners of the tax of the several counties of this State, before the first day of June in each year, a full and fair statement of the amount of fees by the said district justices respectively received.
