SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Issembly of Maryland. That it shall be lawful for the commissioners of Baltimore county to levy upon the assessable property of said country, a sum of money notexceeding

property of said county, a sum of money not exceeding a five hundred dollars, for the purpose of erecting a bridge over the Western Run, at the place hereinbefore mentioned, if they in their judgment shall deem a bridge necessary, and that it is expedient to erect the same, and that in case the said county commissioners shall deem it expedient to build said bridge, they shall impoint three commissioners to fix upon a site for erecting the same, at or near the aforesaid factory, and

Name commiss ers appoint three commissioners to hix upon a site for erecting the same, at or near the aforesaid factory, and the said bridge commissioners shall also contract with some person, or persons, for erecting said bridge, who shall give bond and security to the said bridge commissioners for building the same in a good and substantial manner.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the county-commissioners shall allow to said bridge commissioners, such reasonable compensation, as they may deen right and proper, for the time said bridge commissioners shall be actually employed in the discharge of their duties under the provisions of this act.
