

**CHAP. 351.** companies, by an act entitled, an act prescribing general regulations for the incorporation of manufacturing and mining companies, passed the twenty-eighth day of March, eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, and said company is hereby made subject to the restrictions and regulations prescribed in said act.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the capital stock of said company shall not be less than twenty thousand dollars, nor more than one hundred thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of one hundred dollars each, and that the said company shall have the right to purchase and hold any lots of land in the city of Baltimore, and real estate in Baltimore county, not exceeding one thousand acres.
