CHAPTER 352.

An act to confirm and make valid the acts of Stephen Roach, as Justice of the Peace, in and for Worcester county, from eighteen hundred and thirty-three to eighteen hundred and thirty-eight, inclusive. Passed April 2,
1839.

WHEREAS, it is represented to this General Assembly, that Stephen Roach, has been regularly appointed by the Governor and Council, a justice of the peace in and for Worcester county, from the year eighteen hundred and thirty-three to eighteen hundred and thirty eight, inclusive; and whereas, it is also represented that no certificate of his (the said Stephen's) qualification as justice of the peace as aforesaid, can be found filed in the office of the clerk of Worcester county court, for that period; and whereas, great injustice and inconvenience might ensue to parties interested, growing out of this omission:—Therefore.
