Sec. 5. And be it enacted, That the commissioners County for St. Mary's county, be, and they are hereby substituted for and invested with all the powers of the commissioners of the free school fund of St. Mary's countv. and the Treasurer of the Western Shore, is hereby required to pay over to the said commissioners for St. Mary's county, or to their order, annually, such pro-

portion of the school fund as said county may be entitled to receive.

Sec. 6.
