CHAPTER 365.

*An act to divorce Sarah Sentz, of Carroll County, from her husband Andrew Sentz.* Passed April 3, 1839.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Divorce  
That Sarah Sentz, of Carroll county, be, and she is hereby divorced from her husband Andrew Sentz, *a mensa et thoro.*
