## CHAPTER 366.

Passed April 4, 1839. *An act to make valid the Diplomas granted by the Medical Faculty of the University of Maryland, from eighteen hundred and twenty-six, up to April, eighteen hundred and thirty-nine.*

Confirmation

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That all the Diplomas granted to Graduates by the Medical Faculty of the University of Maryland, from eighteen hundred and twenty-six, up to April, eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, be, and the same are hereby declared to be valid, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.*

## CHAPTER 367.

Passed April 3, 1839. *An act to incorporate the Maryland Shot Tower Company.*

Persons incorporated

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Henry S. Sanderson, James Wilkes, jr., George Gordon Belt, Thomas Whitridge, Thomas Wildey, John I. Gross, Samuel G. Hyde, and such other persons as may be hereafter associated with them, shall be, and they are hereby incorporated and made a body politic and corporate, under the name and style of the Maryland Shot Tower Company, for the purpose of manufacturing and vending shot, and prosecution of all such other operations as may grow out of, or be connected with the said business and the said corporation, under the name and style of the Maryland Shot Tower Company, is hereby invested with all the rights and privileges and powres conferred upon such companies, by an act entitled an act prescribing general regulation for the incorporation of manufacturing and mining companies, passed the twenty-eighth day of March, eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, and the said company is hereby made subject to the restrictions and regulations prescribed in said act.*
