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CHAPTER 55.

*An act relating to Public Roads in Carroll County.* Passed Feb. 9,  
1839.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Act of 1825, chap.  
219, and of 1837,  
chap. 250, applied  
to Carroll county  
That from and after the passage of this act, the act en-  
titled, an act to regulate the manner of obtaining and  
altering public roads in Baltimore county, passed at  
December session eighteen hundred and twenty-five,  
chapter two hundred and nineteen, and the act, entitl-  
ed, an act to enlarge the powers of the Commissioners  
of Baltimore County, passed at December session  
eighteen hundred and thirty-seven, chapter two hun-  
dred and fifty-nine, shall apply to Carroll county, and  
that the commissioners of tax of Carroll county be,  
and they are hereby authorised to exercise all the pow-  
ers vested in the commissioners of Baltimore county  
by the said acts.

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CHAPTER 56.

*An act to repeal an act therein mentioned, and to give to* Passed Feb. 9,  
1839.  
*all the voters of Harford county an equal voice in*  
*electing their County Commissioners.*
