Payment to Denton Academy directed

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said Orphan's Court, be, and they are hereby authorised and directed to pay over on the first day of May next, to the trustees of the Denton Academy, and their successors in office, all sums of money which may be remaining in the hands of the said Orphan's Court, for, and on account of the donation to the Colleges and Academies of this State, paid to the said Orphan's Court, by the Treasurer of the Western Shore, and the said Orphan's Court, are hereby authorized and directed to pay the said trustees and their successors, on the first day of January, in each and every year thereafter, the full amount of the said donation to the Colleges and Academies of this State, as the same may be received from the said Treasurer of the Western Shore, to be applied by the said trustees in the erection and support of an Academy, in the town of Denton; *provided*, that the said Academy, from and after the first day of January next, shall not be entitled to receive from the said court any portion of the interest arising on the surplus revenue, but the portion of said fund belonging to the middle district of said county, shall be distributed amongst the other schools in said district, authorized by law to receive the same, in exclusion of said Academy.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That so much of the sixteenth section of an act, passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty-four, chapter two hundred and twelve, as requires the Register of Wills of said county, to record the reports and returns of the commissioners of the Free and Charity school fund of said county, to the Orphan's Court, and all the reports and certificates of the trustees of the located schools in said county, and so much of the seventeenth section of the aforesaid act, as requires that the justices of the Orphan's Court, shall annex all the reports of the district commissioners and trustees of the located schools to their returns to the General Assembly, be,
