Commissioners to
be elected October
1840

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That a new election for Commissioners for Harford County shall take place on the day of holding the annual general election in October, eighteen hundred and forty, any thing contained in any law then existing to the contrary notwithstanding.

Clerk to attend

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That from and after the first day of April next, it shall be the duty of the clerk to the county commissioners of Harford county to give his personal attendance at the court house, during the usual hours of business, every Tuesday, during the time of his continuing to hold said office of clerk; and in case any person holding said office of clerk shall fail or neglect to attend as aforesaid, unless disabled by sickness or prevented by some other circumstance beyond his control, his said office shall thereupon be deemed to be vacated; and the county commissioners shall, at their next meeting thereafter, appoint some other person in his place.

CHAPTER 57.

Passed Feb. 9,
1839. *An act to repeal an act, entitled, a further supplement to an act to provide for the public instruction of youth in Primary Schools in this State.*

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That an act of Assembly, entitled, a further supplement to an act to provide for the public instruction of youth in primary schools in this State, passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty-seven, chapter three hundred and six, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That all acts or parts of acts which being inconsistent with the said act were repealed thereby, be, and the same are from and after the passage of this act hereby revived.
