Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Rev. Mr. McElheny, and the Rev. Mr. Vinton, or order, one hundred and fifty dollars each, as a compensation for their services, during the present session of the Legislature.

No. 65.

Resolution in favor of the Maryland Hospital.

Passed April 3, 1839.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore of Maryland, be, and he is hereby authorised and directed to pay to the President and Visitors of the Maryland Hospital, or to their order, the sum of thirty thousand dollars in six equal annual payments, from and after the passage of this resolution; to be by them applied for the benefit and improvement of said Bospital; distinct reference being had, in making the improvements, to its exclusive use as a Lunatic Asylum: provided, the said president and visitors shall give bond and security, to be approved by the Treasurer, for the faithful disbursement and application of said sum of money; and also provided, that one half of said institution shall hereafter be appropriated to the accommodation of pauper lunatics of this State, who shall there be accommodated and treated at the expense of the county so sending such lunatic paupers; provided the same shall not exceed one hundred dollars for each nauner lunatic so sent.
