## CHAPTER 69.

Passed Feb. 15, An act to provide for the erection of an additional wharf
1839. at the town of Nottingham in Prince George's County, for the shipment of Tobacco. from the public
warchouse in that Town.

Preamble

WHEREAS it is represented to this General Assembly by the petition of sundry citizens in the neighbor of Nothingham, in Prince Georgés county, that they labour under serious inconvenience for the want of a proper wharf for the shipment of Tobacco from the pupile warehouse in that flowing—Therefore.

Commissioners :

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Issembly of Maryland, That Robert W. Bowie, Michael B. Carroll, and Henry M. Chew, of Prince George's county, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners for the parnoses hereinafter mentioned.

Authorised to pur-

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the said commissioners or a majority of them, are hereby authorized and empowered to purchase of any person or persons who may own land bordering on the Pataxent River at the point that may be selected by them as the most eligible for the crection of an additional wharf for the shipment of Tobacco, from the public warehouse in the Town of Nottingham, provided, such purchase and other expenditures shall not exceed the sum of three hundred dollars.

Limit \$300 Contract for creet-

Sec. S. 3ml be it enacted. That the said commissioners or a majority of them, after they shall have compiled with the conditions hereinafter prescribed, be and they are hereby authorized and directed to contract for the erection of an additional wharf in the town of Nottingham, in Prince George's county, of such dimensions as in their judgment will best answer the purposes contemplated by this act.

Whart placed is

Sec. 4. 3nd be it enacted, That the wharf herein directed to be erected, shall be under the control of the Tobacco Inspector for the Tobacco warehouse in said town.

Levy directed

Sec. 5. And be it enacted, That the justices of the levy court of Prince George's county are hereby authorized and empowered as soon as in their discretionit may be necessary after the passage of this act, t
