shall be sold, to remove him or her from the State of
Maryland, and in default of the execution of suchbond by the first purchaser, the said slave shall be
again exposed to sale, and shall not be delivered out of
the custody of the sheriff, until such bond shall have
been filed by the party purchasing.

## CHAPTER 64.

Passed Feb. 15, An act supplementary to an act, entitled, an act to regulate the Inspection of Tobacco in Prince George's-County, passed December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-seven, chapter two hundred and forty-five.

Scales, weights,&c.

Szerios 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryiland, That there shall be provided and kept by the Inspectors at each of the tobacco warehouses in Prince George's County, proper and sufficient beams, prizes, screes, blocks, tackles, weights and scales; and also a set of small weights, such as are pravided for the standing weights of each county, and proper marking irons, scales and all other necessary articles which may be required in the opening, uncasing, and inspection of tobacco, and the said inspectors are hereby required constantly to keep the same in good repair, under the penalty of one hundred dollars, and the clarges and expenses thereof shall be paid by the said inspectors, out of the money accruing to the State from their research; warchouses, and they shall be allowed.
