hands for collection during the time he was in office, CHAP. 69. and which have not been collected, in the same manner as he could or might have done within the time

limited by law.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the said Richard R. May toke and by Waters, be and he is hereby also authorised to take assignments upon any claims which may have been placed in his hands as sheriff, for collection, and which he has paid; and to proceed to recover upon such assigned claims in the same manner as he might or could have done, whilst in the office of sheriff.

Sec. S. And be it enacted, That the said Richard accounts und R. Waters, before he proceeds to execute the body or property of any person, by the authority of this act. shall deliver or cause to be delivered to such person or persons chargeable with the same, at least thirty days previous to serving or levying such execution, a specific account of the sum demanded of him, her or them, with an affidavit annexed thereto, that he hath not, nor

hath any person or persons acting under him, whilst sheriff or since, received any part thereof, or satisfaction for the same, to the best of his knowledge and helief

CHAPTER 69.

A supplement to an act entitled an act concerning Crimes Passed Feb. 6. and Punishment, passed December session, eighteen 1839. hundred and thirty-five, chapter two hundred.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of care of sale of cor Maryland, That in all cases wherein any free negro or free mulatto convict, shall be ordered to be sold without the limits of the State, pursuant to the provisions of the third section of an act of Assembly, passed at December session, eighteen bundred and thirty-five, chapter two hundred, to which this is a supplement, there shall be allowed and paid, by the one fourth of pre sheriff or other officer making said sale, out of the saion proceeds thereof, after defraying the expenses of the prosecution of the said free negroes or mulattoes, to the officer or officers apprehending and prosecuting said free negroes or mulattoes to conviction, one fourth
