CHAPTER 72.

An act to authorise the Clerk of Montgomery County Court to remove the records and public documents of said county to another office. Passed F. b. 23,

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Clerk of Montgomery County Court be, and he is hereby authorised, directed and required to remove the records and public documents of said county, so far as he may deem it necessary for the security thereof and the public convenience, into the department provided and appropriated to his use, in the court house lately erected in said county. CHAPTER 73.

An act to authorise the Levy Court of Frederick County, and the Commissioners of the Tax of Carroll County, to erect a Bridge over Little Pipe Creek, at or near the grist mill of Daniel P.
