CHAP. 96.

An act authorizing the Levy Court of Frederick County, Passed Feb. 27. win their discretion to levy a sum of money to build a bridge over the Monococy River, at Devilbiss Ford, on the wood to Liberta

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Lory of \$1. Maryland, That the Judges of the Levy Court of Frederick county, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, in their discretion, to levy a sum of money not exceeding five thousand dollars, on the assessable property in said county, in three annual in- Three annual paystalments, for the purpose of building a bridge over the Monococy river, at Devilbiss Ford, on the road to Liberty.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted. That the Levy Court Contract auth aforesaid, be and the same are hereby authorized to contract with any person or persons to build said bridge, and are required to take bond or bonds, with sufficient security, from any contractor or contractors. for the faithful performance of his, or their contract in the usual form

CHAPTER 96.

An act to abolish the Commissioners of the Tax and Le-Passed Feb. 27. 1839 vy Court of Worcester County, provide for the election. of Commissioners for said county by the people, and to prescribe their duties.
