And be it enacted, That the said commis- Compensation dellars ner sioners shall be entitled to receive two dollars per day each, for each and every day he shall necessarily attend to the duties of his office, and six and a quarter And mileage cents for every mile he may have to travel to the place of meeting of the said commissioners; provided, that nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to allow the said county commissioners mileage after the first day's attendance, whenever said commissioners shall adjourn from day to day for the transaction of husiness.

Sec. 14. And be it enacted. That all suits at law. Suits, &c. continu or in equity, which may be pending at the time of the passage of this act, by, or against the justices of the levy court of said county, shall be carried on in like manner, and have the same legal effect, either in favor of, or against the commissioners provided for by this act, as if said suit or suits had been instituted by or against the said commissioners.
