An additional supplement to an act entitled, an act for Passed Feb. 19, the appointment of Commissioners for the regulation

1899,
and improvement of Cambridge, in Dorchester county, and to establish and regulate the market in said
Town.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Princetons Maryland, That the commissioners of the town of Cambridge, shall be and they are hereby authorised and empowered, to cause the streets of the town of Cambridge to be pared, whenever, and in such manner as a majority of the said commissioners shall require the same to be done.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the said commis-Propotent may be sioners may require the owner or owners, of any ground in Cambridge to pave, when and in the manner they shall direct, such part or parts of the street as may border on his, her or their ground.

Scc. 3. And be it enacted, That if the owner or own case of a fau ground bordering on any one or more of the streets required to be paved by the said commissioners, shall refuse or neglect to have the same paved as aforesaid, for a longer time than three months, after he, she, or they, shall have been required to pave Morphise state the same, then it shall and may be lawful for the said to have the same paved, in the manner, aforesaid, commissioners at the proper cost and charge of the owner or owners.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That if the said owner or May esteen owners, shall refuse to pay the same, or delay in so doing for a longer time than one month, after the said costs and charges shall have been demanded, then the said commissioners may proceed to collect the same, as small debts are now collected by law.
