Sec. 9. And be it enacted. That if any retailer or Chap. 104, retailers of any spirituous, fermented or malt liquors, retailers shall continue to retail as aforesaid, after the cancellation or withdrawal of their license or licenses, then the said retailer or retailers, shall be subject to the same penalties as are now imposed by law, on individuals for selling without license.

CHAPTER 105.

An act to outhorise Caleb White, collector of taxes in Passed Mar. 1,
the second collection district of Anne Arundel county,
further time to complete his collections.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Ambound to en-Maryland, That Caleb White, collector of the second collection district of Anne Arundle cointry, be and he is hereby authorised and empowered, to collect any taxes, or balance of taxes, now remaining due to, and intellected by him, in the district aforesaid, in the same manner and with the same power and privileges, as are allowed by the existing laws; in said cases, made and provided.

Sec. 2. Ind be it enacted, That the aforesaid Calch dromas to be White, shall in every instance, before he may proceed some to the aforesaid collection, make affidavit before some justice of the peace of said county, that the same remains unpaid, and that he hath not received any security, or satisfaction for the same, or any part thereaf, more than what credits may be allowed thereon.

Sec. s. And be it enacted, That this act shall not Limit tyme continue in force longer than one year from the date of the passage thereof.
