CHAPTER 107.

A supplement to an act for the relief of Samuel G. Holbrook, late Sheriff of Somerset County. Passed Mar. 14
1839.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Time extended
That the time allowed Samuel G. Holbrook, late Sheriff of Somerset county, to complete his collections, by an act of Assembly passed December session eighteen hundred and thirty-seven, chapter sixty seven, be and the same is hereby extended to the first day of May, eighteen hundred and forty.

CHAPTER 108.

An act relating to the compensation payable by officers to the Sheriff of Harford County, for the collecting of officers' fees. Passed Mar. 1,
1839.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, 12 1/2 per cent commission
That from and after the passage of this act it shall and may be lawful for the sheriff of Harford county to charge and receive from all officers, who may choose to require of the sheriff to collect for them, any officers' fees, a commission of twelve and a half per cent on the amount of fees that may be so collected, instead of the commission heretofore allowed in such cases.

CHAPTER 109.

An act to provide for the election of Commissioners for Somerset County, and to enlarge their powers and duties. Passed Mar. 1,
1839.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Election 27th Mar. 1839
That an election shall be held in the several election districts of Somerset county, on Wednesday, the twenty-seventh day of March, eighteen hun-
