distribution and application of said school funds, as the CHAP. 102. managers may find to be expedient and proper; provided, Proviso that such regulations shall not be inconsistent with any of the foregoing sections of this act.

SEC. 9. And be it enacted. That all acts heretofore Repealed passed inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be and the same is hereby repealed.

## CHAPTER 101.

A further and additional supplement to an act, entitled an Passed Mar. 16. act to provide for the relief and support of the Poor and Indigent Persons of Worcester County, passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty-five.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Commissioners That the county commissioners of Worcester, be and to make furthey are hereby authorized and required to levy and assess on the property in said county, according to the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, such further sum or sums of money as the commissioners aforesaid, or a majority of them, may deem necessary to carry out and complete the purpose of the said original act, not exceeding in the whole, the sum of forty dollars.
