ces, are not to be delayed in receiving what may be due to them by reason of any delay there may in the said counties or city paying each other.

CHAPTER 111.

An act to provide for the more equal distribution among Passed Mar 13, the different Academies in Carroll County, of the State's 1840. donation for the benefit of Academies in said County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Denations, &c. Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore of Maryland be, and he is heteby authorized and required to pay, annually, to the following cacdemies in Carroll county, out of the State's donation for the benefit of academies in said county, in the manner following, to wit: to the Manchester academy, two hundred dollars; to the Carroll academy, one hundred and fifty dollars; to the Uniontown academy, one hundred dollars; to the Deer Creek academy, does hundred dollars; to the Deer Creek academy, one hundred dollars; to the Oakland academy, one hundred dollars; and to the Oakland academy, one hundred dollars; and to the Oakland academy, one hundred dollars.

Sec. 2. Jand be it enacted, That the Treasurer of the Treasure to Western Shore is hereby authorized and required to pay to pay, &c. the aforesaid sums of money to the trustees of said arademies respectively, from time to time, or to their order, as provided for by this act; provided, said tristees Provise comply with the requisitions of the several acts of Assembly prescribing certain duties to the trustees of academies and colleges receiving donations from the State, any law to the coptrary notwithstanding.

CHAPTER 112.

An act regulating the compensation of the County Survey-Passed Mar. 17, or, and prescribing certain duties therein named, so far 1840. as the same relates to Frederick County.
