CHAPTER 14.

An act in furtherance of Justice.

Passed Mar. 7.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Judgment not That a judgment recovered against one or more members of a partnership, or one or more persons jointly liable on any bill, bond, covenant, promissory note, bill of exchange, contract or agreement whatsoever, less than the whole number of partners or persons so bound, shall not work an extinguishment or merger of the cause of action on which such judgment may have been rendered, as respects the liability of the partners or persons not bound by such judgment, and they shall remain liable to be sued as if their original responsibility had been joint and several; provided altosays, that but one satisfaction of the debt Provise.

CHAPTER 15.

An act entitled, a further supplement to an act entitled, an Passed Mar. 5, act relating to Free Negroes and Slaves 1840.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Permission to Maryland, That it shall be lawful for any citizen of this remove slaves State, or for any person or persons who reside or may have resided out of this State, and who may remove, or have removed into the same, with a bona fide intention of becoming a citizen thereof, to introduce into this State any negro slave or slaves for life, from any State, district, or territory of the United States; provided, the person so Provis removing, shall within thirty days after the removal of such slave or slaves into the State, make affidavit before some justice of the peace of the county into which he or she may remove, and have the same filed in the office of the clerk of the county court of said county, of his or her intention to become a citizen of the State; and provided Further proviso also, that the person so introducing such slave or slaves shall within the time aforesaid, file with the said clerk a list or lists of the said slave or slaves so removed, stating their ages, with an affidavit thereto attached, that the same is a true and faithful list or lists of said slaves so removed; and that he or she hath not removed the same into the State for the purpose of sale, and that they are
