### CHAPTER 116.

*An act supplemental to an act, providing for the appointment of Lime Inspectors for the City of Baltimore, and prescribing their duties, passed December session eighteen hundred and thirty-two.* Passed Mar. 13,  
1840.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That there be annually appointed for the city of Baltimore, two persons well skilled in the quality of lime, to measure and inspect all lime made in, or brought to the city of Baltimore for sale, or to be used therein, in wagons, carts or other carriages, which shall be measured by the Winchester bushel, containing twenty-one hundred and fifty cubic inches. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Mayor be and is hereby authorised to designate two stands for the inspection and measurement of lime, in such part of the city as the public convenience, agreeably to his judgment, may require; and the said inspectors shall change their stands alternately, on the Monday of each week.
