Exampt from Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, county taxes That the property of the Protestant Episcopal Charletes in Calvert county, be and the same is hereby released from the payment of county taxes, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

CHAPTER 121.

Passed Mar. 13, An act for the benefit of the Crier of Carroll County 1840.

Compensation of crier

That the crier of Carroll county court shall be entitled to receive one dollar, in addition to his fees, for each day he shall attend upon the session of said court, and that the same be levied upon the assessable property of said courty, and paid as other county charges.

WHEREAS, it is represented to this General Assembly, that David G. Odel, late sheriff of Worcester compy, failed to give bond for the last two years of his sheriffally, without any fault of his, and that he acted as sheriff during those years notwithstanding the absence of such bonds.

That all-acts done by the said David G. Odell, in his said
office of sheriff of Worcester county, during the years for
which he failed to give bond according to law, shall be
