Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That the corporation hereby created, shall not issue or put in circulation, or cause to bianting formid be issued or put in circulation, any bill, note, check, device or evidence of debt whatsoever, to be used as currency or money; and that the General Assembly hereby reserves the right at any time to repeal, alter or amend this charter when the same shall be deemed advisable.

## CHAPTER 151.

An act to incorporate the Directors of the Book Concern of Passed Jan. 30, the Methodist Protestant Church.

WHEREAS, sundry persons, hereinafter named, have Preamble better appointed by the proper authorities of the Methodist Protestant Church, to conduct a Book Establishment or Concern, in the city of Baltimore, with a view of furnishing the community with appropriate books and publications of a religious and literary character, and have prayed for an act of incorporation, that they may be better enabled to carry such purpose into effect—therefore.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Individuals in-
