CHAPTER 18.

Passed Mar. 11, 1840. *An act supplementary to an act, entitled an act to declare and ascertain the right of citizens of this State to private roads or ways, passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty-four.*

Levy courts, &c. to receive and act on petition asking for road. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That, in addition to the powers conferred upon the levy courts or commissioners, as the case may be, of the several counties of this State, by the act to which this is a supplement, they shall have full power to receive, and shall act upon the petition of any person or persons owning land in counties adjoining their several counties, asking for a road, and that said levy courts or county commissioners, as the case may be, shall act upon the petition or petitions so made, precisely in the same manner as if the petitioner was a citizen of the county in which said levy courts or commissioners, as the case may be, have power to act.

CHAPTER 19.

Passed Mar. 10, 1840. *An act to regulate the measurement of Oats.*

To be by struck measure. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That all oats bought and sold in this State, shall be by struck measure.

CHAPTER 20.

Passed Mar. 14, 1840. *An act to provide for an exchange of certain Stock therein mentioned.*

Commissioner of loans to issue certificates of stock, &c. **SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Commissioner of Loans be, and he is hereby authorized and directed, to issue, and to sell
