CHAPTER 163.

An act to incorporate the Friendship Academy, in Anne Passed Feb. 21, Arundel County.

WHEREAS, application has been made to the General Preamble Assembly of Maryland, for the purpose of a law to incorporate the Friendship Academy, in Anne Arundel county—therefore,

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Trustees named Maryland, That Benjamin Carr, Joseph G. Harrison and John Scrivener, be and they are hereby appointed the first trustees of said academy; and the said trustees, and their Incorporated successors, to be elected in the manner hereinafter mentioned, shall be and they are hereby declared to be one community, corporation and body politic, to all intents and purposes, connected with the said institution, by the Name and style name and style of the Friendship Academy; by which name and title, they and their successors shall be compe- Corporate powtent and capable in law and equity, to take and hold to ers themselves and their successors, for the use of the said academy, any estate in messuages, lands, tenements, annuities, goods, chattels, monies or effects, by gift, grant or bargain, sale, conveyance, devise or bequest, of any person or persons whatsoever; provided, the same do not Limit exceed in the whole, clear yearly value of two thousand
