Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That in the event of any vacancy or vacancies occurring, by death, resignation or otherwise, in the board of Elders, Deacons and Trustees of the German Reformed church in the city of Baltimore, it shall be lawful for said board, or a majority of them, to fill such vacancy or vacancies as
