## CHAPTER 198.

An act to authorise John Leatherberry, late Collector of Passed Jan. 14, Somerset County, to complete his collections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Tomake collec-That John Leatherberry, late collector of Somerset county, tion be and he is hereby authorised and empowered from and after the passage of this act, until the first day of June, in the year eighteen hundred and forty-one, to collect and receive any and every balance or amount of officers fees, chancery taxes and fines, forfeitures and county taxes, or public dues whatsoever, which he was authorised by law to collect during the term of his office as collector as aforesaid, and which has not yet been collected, in the same manner and with the same effect, powers and privileges, as if the term of his said office had not expired; provided, that Proviso the said Leatherberry shall not proceed to collect or receive any balance or amount aforesaid, until he shall have made several affidavit before some justice of the peace of said county, or when the estate of a deceased person is affected before the register of wills for said county, that said balance or amount is justly due, and he hath not received any payment, security or satisfaction for the same, or any part thereof, nor any person for him, save the credits if any given, on the written statement or account of said balance or amount; nor until a certificate of such affidavit by the officer taking the same, shall have been endorsed on said written statement or account, or annexed thereto.
