shall be conducted as prescribed and provided for by the CHAP. 206. original act.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That the commissioners of To enact by-Middletown shall have power and authority to enact and laws pass by-laws and ordinances for the purchase and keeping in repair and preservation an engine and apparatus for the extinguishment of fires in said town.

CHAPTER 206.

An act to incorporate the Methodist Sunday School Society, Passed Feb. 24, of the North Baltimore Station.

WHEREAS, it is represented to this General Assembly Preamble of Maryland, that Thomas G. Hill, Columbus A. Leaman, Samuel Hindes, George Sander , Joseph Farrow, William Rodgers, John Hurley, Rol ert Bolton, Frances Turner, James S. Suter, Jacob Day and Samuel Kirk, of the city of Baltimore, have formed themselves into a society for the purpose of teaching children on the Sabbath, and are desirous of obtaining an act of incorporation to enable them more fully to carry into effect their benevolent design; and whereas, this General Assembly is willing to aid and encourage an institution so truly praiseworthy in its object-therefore,

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Incorporated Maryland, That the aforesaid persons, and such other persons as may hereafter be admitted into the said society agreeably to the present constitution, rules and bye-laws of the same, or such alterations and amendments of the constitution, or new rules and regulations as may hereafter be made and adopted by the said society, shall be and they and their successors are hereby declared to be one community, corporation and body politic, by the name and style of the Name and style "Methodist Sunday School Society of the North Baltimore Station," and by that name they shall be and are Corporate powhereby made able and capable in law, to have, purchase, ere receive, hold, possess, enjoy and retain to them and their successors, in fee or less estate or estates, any lands, grounds, tenements, rents, annuities, chattels, United States stock, or other stock or stocks within this State, whether the same be acquired by gift, purchase or devise of, or from any person or persons, bodies politic or corpo-
