also devises and bequests of any person or persons, bodies CHAP. 214. corporate or politic, capable of making the same, and the same at their pleasure, to transfer or dispose of in such manner as they may think proper; provided always, that Limit \$3,000 the said corporation or body politic, shall not at any time hold or possess property, real, personal or mixed, exceeding in actual value the sum of three thousand dollars.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That any building that may Buildings, &c. hereafter be erected in the town of Cumberland, for the exempt from use of said corporation, and the ground and appurtenances thereto attached, be and the same is hereby released

from taxation for county purposes.

SEC. 4. Ind be it emacted, That nothing berein contain-Banking forbided shall be so construed as to authorize or empower said corporation to issue any notes, certificate, token or evidence of debt, to be used as a currency; and the right Rights reserved is hereby expressly reserved to the General Assembly of Maryland, at its pleasure, to alter, amend or annul this act of incorporation.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That this act shall continue In force and be in force for the period of thirty years and no longer, from the passage thereof.

CHAPTER 214.

An act to authorise the closing of part of an Alley in Ha-Passed Mar. 4.
gerstown. — 1840

WHEREAS, it has been represented to this General As-Preamble sembly, that the Franklin rail road company, which is now engaged in the construction of a rail road from the Pennsylvania State line to Hagerestown, in Washington county, Maryland, will require as part of a depot for said rail road, that portion of a twelve feet alley in said town, which lies midway between west Washington and Franklin streets, commencing at Walnut street and running in a westwardly direction, the distance of one hundred and twenty-fipe feet.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Authority to that the said Franklin rail road company, be and they are close alley hereby authorised and empowered to take possession of, close up and occupy for the use of such depot, that portion of said alley, which is mentioned and described in the preamble to this act, and that the right, title, use and oc-
