

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That if the commissioners of Saint Mary's county should deem it expedient, they shall have power to remove and re-construct said bridge at any other point over said river or stream which they may deem more desirable; *provided*, that in no event the expenditure on said bridge shall exceed the sum of five hundred dollars, as named in the act to which this is a supplement.

CHAPTER 239.

An act to divorce Sarah W. Love, of Baltimore County, from her husband Christopher C. Love. Passed Mar. 11, 1840.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sarah W. Love, of Baltimore county, be and she is hereby divorced from her husband Christopher C. Love, a vinculo matrimonii.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said Sarah W. Love is hereby authorised and entitled to have the guardianship of her child.

CHAPTER 240.

An act to divorce Charles Frederick Berger, from his wife Margaret Berger. Passed Mar. 11, 1840.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Charles Frederick Berger, of the city of Baltimore, be and he is hereby divorced from his wife Margaret Berger, a vinculo matrimonii.
