SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That when the said com-To pay prizes missioners, shall in place of selling a scheme, sell the drawn, &c. tickets therein, it shall be the duty of the commissioners to pay the prizes which may be drawn to such tickets, which obligation shall be deemed to be within the condi-

tion of their bond or bonds aforesaid.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That any vacancies that Vacancies how may from time to time occur by resignation, death, declifiled ning to act, or any other cause, in the board of the said commissioners, shall be filled by the commissioners of Caroline county, the persons appointed to such vacancies To bend being however hereby required before they shall be competent to act, to enter into bond with sureties and condition and in penalty as prescribed by the second section of this act in reard to the commissioners herein named.
