Smith, of Clearfield county, in the State of Pennsylvania, on certain trusts and for certain purposes in said deed mentioned, bearing date on the twenty-eighth day of September, in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty-seven; and tohereas, it is also represented, the said deed of conveyance has not been acknowledged or record-
