Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Divorce That Lucinda Massey, of the city of Baltimore, be and she is hereby divorced from her husband Thomas Massey, a vinculo matrimonii.

CHAPTER 246.

An act in aid of the construction of a Stone or other Wharf Passed Mar. 14, at Cambridge, in Dorchester County.

WHEREAS, the citizens of Dorchester county propose Preamble and desire to have made a stone or other wharf at Cambridge, in said county; and whereas, the said undertaking will subserve materially the public convenience and interests; and it is represented that to accomplish this highly useful object, adequate means cannot be procured, save through the privilege of a lottery-Therefore,

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Commissioners Maryland, That H. Page, Thomas White, Shadrach appointed Mitchel, Thomas Breerwood and James Dixon, of Dor-
